We set a goal in late 2020, with a quality space in mind and years of planning and development, to open our Nonprofit branch of Forefront Therapy. In a time that saw delays in shipping and construction product production due to the pandemic (i.e. 6 month delay on window shipping), we were able to meet our deadline for a May 2021 clinic opening for Forefront Therapy-The Bronstein Clinic. We are proud to say that we used 100% local companies for the entire renovation of the 201 SE 4th St. space, conveniently located in the heart of Downtown Evansville.



This hard work and collaboration resulted in a 4,100 sq.ft. beautifully renovated space and a dedicated 14 space parking lot. The first floor has ample space for clinical success and the second floor is set up for a warm and fresh administrative atmosphere. Part of the vision of the space also included a successful renovation of the 1st floor roof to create an amazing 2nd floor terrace of which will be a staple of future team and fundraising events for the organization for years to come. Furnishing the space came with extensive challenges again from side effects of the pandemic as well as initial funding challenges. However, we were able to persevere and properly equip and furnish the clinic in time for the opening.

Our organization has been able to host educational events, participate in multiple local community events, host a Run/Walk 812 Health Fair fundraiser, collaborate with multiple organizations, multiple PDEvv Hub events and support, as well as continue to successfully grow clinical volume and success each and every month.

We have seen steady and successful monthly growth with patient volume, being able to assist 153 individuals in 2021.
